Magic Moments

We use Magic Moments in Reception. We love it when parents/carers let us know some of the amazing things their child has been up to at home. These are celebrated in front of the whole class then displayed on the wall!

Communication

- We use an app called Tapestry to track the children's learning, and share important messages with you.
- Forest School is on Mondays, children come dressed in long sleeves and long trousers.
- PE is on Tuesday, children come dressed in PE kits.
- Book change day is Monday.
- Phonics homework is sent home on a Friday and due back on Thursday.

Transition

Children have a staggered start to Reception based on their age, so they can settle with confidence.

Moving to Year 1 we make sure the children spend time with their next teacher and experience their new classroom.
