# Actions arising from 2021/22 survey

**Options for longer parents evening would be great as it feels rushed: review process timeframes.**

**Sometimes communication is last minute:** ensure information is sent in a timely manner, but mindful that last minute changes are sometimes avoidable.

**Greater emphasis on emotional literacy:** a great deal is done at school around this topic, but we are working hard on children being able to explain their feelings. This will remain central to our work.

**More information on my child's progress:** we will review the processes presently in place.

**Community involvement:** links will become more possible as Covid recedes.

**Greater links with the Junior School:** this is well underway, and we look forward to a joint Jubilee celebration

**Understanding the core of behaviour communication:** behaviour is communication, and we work hard to unpick the behaviours we see. Working closely with families helps greatly.

**More talk of diversity and cultural differences:** meetings taking place to address this. Curriculum review.

**More inclusive initiatives:** we will review past initiatives and plan more inclusively moving forward.

# All of these actions have taken place



**Some parents do not know if homework is appropriate at this school:** We will review our homework policy and make sure this is clearly communicated to parents.


















