School Uniform Guide

We believe a simple and practical uniform helps to create a sense of belonging and pride among our pupils. Below, you will find all the information you need about the school uniform requirements.

Where to buy uniform

PMG Schoolwear are our main uniform supplier and offer items with and without logos. You can:

- visit the PMG Schoolwear shop in central High Wycombe to view and purchase items
- order online by visiting 'https://pmgschoolwear.co.uk/, and selecting 'Carrington Infant School' from the schools drop down or click here
- purchase an iron-on school logo from PMG Schoolwear to apply to non-branded items that need to have a school logo
- buy unbranded uniform items from any major supermarket or retailer, as long as they meet the uniform requirements below
- buy from the school secondhand uniform shop for £1 per item. Please contact the school office to browse and purchase.

Uniform requirements

Please ensure items have a school logo on where this is specified below.

Full School Uniform

Weather appropriate uniform can be worn at any time in the year (i.e. no winter / summer requirements). Full school uniform is usually worn 3 times a week in reception and twice a week in years 1 & 2.

- Bottoms: Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- **Tops:** White shirt, blouse, or polo shirt
- Jumper: Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with school logo)
- Socks or tights: White or grey socks or grey tights
- Footwear: Sensible black school shoes (no trainers)
- Optional: Royal blue fleece (with school logo)
- Optional: Blue and white striped or checked dress (for warm weather)

Bags

- Book bag for daily use: Blue book bag, available from PMG Schoolwear (with school logo)
- Forest school kit bag: Any drawstring named bag in which to store waterproof trousers and jackets in school and to send them home in for washing
- Small rucksack (year 1 and 2): For school trips when children carry their own drink, lunch and coat and useful if they go swimming in year 2

P. E. Kit

P.E. kit is worn to school on P.E. days, usually worn once a week in reception and twice a week in years 1 & 2.

- Bottoms: Royal blue or navy tracksuit trousers or shorts
- **Tops:** White or blue t-shirt
- Jumper: Royal blue or navy tracksuit top / hoodie / zip-up (with school logo)
- Socks: White or grey socksFootwear: Dark coloured trainers





Forest School Kit

Forest school kit is worn to school on forest school days, usually once a week in all years. The waterproofs are left at school and returned if they become particularly dirty or at the end of term.





- Waterproof jacket: Royal blue or navy
- Waterproof trousers: Royal blue or navy
- Bottoms: Royal blue or navy tracksuit trousers
- **Top:** Royal blue long sleeve T-shirt (with school logo)
- **Jumper:** Royal blue or navy tracksuit top / hoodie / zip-up (with school logo)
- Socks: White or grey socks
- **Footwear:** Dark coloured trainers to wear to school and wellies to be kept in school

Important: Arms and legs must be covered in forest school for health and safety reasons (e.g. nettles, brambles or ticks) regardless of weather conditions.

Jewellery and Hair

- No fashion jewellery is permitted.
- Pupils with pierced ears may wear small studs which MUST be removed for P.E.
- Long hair should always be tied back for health and safety reasons.
- No extreme hairstyles e.g. bright colours, spikes or tramlines

Important reminder: Label all items

May we please request that all items be <u>clearly marked with your child's name</u>. This helps us return lost property efficiently. We are unable to return items of lost property where there is no name.

Progression to Carrington Junior School

The school uniform at the Junior school is aligned with the Infants, but there will be slight variations between year 2 and year 3.
