This week, our school has been buzzing with excitement as we celebrated Bug Week, and it has been wonderful to see every class so fully engaged in their learning. Each year group explored a different creature—from snails and worms in Hazel and Beech, to butterflies, moths, bees and beetles in Key Stage One—using stories, poetry and creative activities to deepen their understanding. Children began by observing and discussing their chosen bug, before heading outdoors to hunt for them around the school grounds, sparking curiosity and scientific thinking. They have created imaginative “superpower” posters, created spontaneous poems, discovered fascinating facts, and even designed and built homes for their bugs, considering how to keep them safe and well-fed. The week has been brought to life through beautiful artwork, with children using a range of techniques including printing, acrylics and watercolours to create stunning pieces inspired by their insects.
